

Seismic Public Meeting Notice

To the Citizens and Landowners of Cameron Parish, Louisiana

Geokinetics Inc. will be conducting seismic activity in a 24.43-square mile project area and the area is west of the town of Cameron. The project area is between Sabine and Calcasieu Lakes, but south of the Sabine National Wildlife Refuge. Project extends approximately 6 miles north of Gulf Beach HWY 82. The purpose of this survey is to provide a high-resolution image of the subsurface geological features that will allow the client to effectively evaluate the hydrocarbon reserves underlying the project area. The survey requires the deployment of motion sensing devices (geophones or receivers), which would be deployed at regular intervals (220 feet), with spacing between receiver lines of 660 to 1,320 feet. The survey design would also incorporate an energy source, which would be placed at regular intervals in a grid pattern.

There will be a public meeting located at the Johnson Bayou Recreation Center starting at 6:00 P.M. on April 3, 2017 to answer any questions pertaining to this seismic survey.

The survey will begin April 5, 2017 and last until July 1, 2017.
