

SEISMIC PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

To the Citizens and Landowners of Tangipahoa, Livingston and St. John the Baptist parishes, Louisiana

Exodus, Inc., on behalf of Air Products, will be conducting seismic activity on Lake Maurepas and the surrounding area, including the swamp area to the north and the mouth of the Tickfaw River. The project will include use of 3D receivers and seismic sources to produce the survey data.

The survey is expected to begin on portions of the area on approximately October 15, 2022 and will last until all portions of the survey area are completed on approximately March 11, 2023. The survey should not prevent recreational or commercial use of the lake or river.

To provide the public with additional information regarding the seismic survey, Exodus, Inc. and the Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries will hold a public meeting at 6:00 pm on Wednesday, August 24. The meeting will be held at the Regala Gymnasium, located at 200 Regala Drive, Reserve Louisiana, 70084.
