

OYSTER IMPORTATION APPLICATION

Filing application does NOT guarantee approval for import. Permits are issued on a case-by case-basis. Applicants will be notified in writing of decision on permit issuance. Applications may take up to 10 business days once all required documents are received. Issued permits are valid for 1 year from permit approval date. Two business days' notice must be given prior to importing and copy of permit and all accompanying permit documents must be kept with the oysters being imported throughout transport or delivery.
