HOW CAN I HAVE MY DEER TESTED FOR CWD?

LDWF and LSU have teamed up to offer FREE CWD testing to the public.

Step 1.

- Please record the GPS location of where the deer was harvested.
- To submit a deer head for CWD testing, remove the head about 5 inches below the ear.
- Deer heads may be caped with antlers and skull cap removed.
- DO NOT FREEZE Samples should be refrigerated or saved on ice.



- Step 2.
- Complete the form at www.wlf.louisiana.gov/form/cwd-testing-information.
- Step 3.
- Print the email that you received after completing the form in step 2. Provide that printout to the LDWF staff member who handles your sample.
- Step 4.
- Contact the nearest field office from the list below to coordinate delivery or pickup of the sample.
